SUBJECT: Award of Contract - A Professional Services Agreement for Engineering Services for the North York Road and Harger Road Intersection Reconstruction Project.

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

I move that the Village Board awards a Professional Engineering Services Agreement to Civiltech Engineering, Inc. for the reconstruction of the intersection of North York Road at Harger Road, and the construction of a new underpass structure at Salt Creek Trail, subject to final attorney review and approval. Additionally, I move that the Village Board approves Resolution R-1868.

Background/History: As part of the North York Road at Harger Road Intersection Reconstruction Project, the Village is required to match the \$4,359,860 being provided in federal funding with \$3,132,440 in local funding for a project estimated total of \$7,492,300. Because the project completion spans 2020 and 2021, the Village's local funding will be distributed accordingly over those years. This is a State Bid Project and, bids were opened March 6, 2020. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder for this project is Martam Construction Incorporated in the amount of \$7,365,297.

The low bid for this project has changed the cost as follows:

\$7,365,297	Construction cost of low bid.
\$681,100	Construction Engineering cost.
(\$2,027,960)	STP Federal Funds available for construction and Construction Engineering.
<u>(\$2,331,900)</u>	CMAQ Federal funds available for construction and Construction Engineering.
\$3,686,537	Village participation share for construction and Construction Engineering. This cost has changed due to non-special waste quantity increase.

Recommendation: That the Village Board awards a Professional Engineering Services Agreement to Civiltech Engineering, Inc., for the reconstruction of the intersection of North York Road at Harger Road, subject to final attorney review and approval. RESOLUTION NO. 2020-ENG-AG-EX-R-1868

A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING
THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT
BY AND BETWEEN
THE VILLAGE OF OAK BROOK AND
CIVILTECH ENGINEERING, INC.

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Brook is a municipal corporation with authority provided for and granted pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code to exercise certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Brook (hereinafter referred to as "Village") upon approval of the corporate authorities may enter into an Agreement with another party pursuant to Illinois Statute;

WHEREAS, the Village is improving an intersection at North York Road and Harger Road with the new underpass structure at Salt Creek Trail; the cost of said improvement has necessitated the use of federal funds along with a match of local funding; and

WHEREAS, Civiltech Engineering, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Engineer") is a full-service engineering firm that provides said services to various clients;

WHEREAS, the Village is interested in entering into an agreement with Engineer as a consulting engineer for the purposes of providing design and construction engineering services in connection with the North York Road and Harger Road Intersection Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Brook Corporate Authorities feel that it is in the best interests of the Village of Oak Brook to enter into the attached agreement with Civiltech Engineering, Inc. for the purposes referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this resolution as legislative findings.

Section Two – Approval of Agreement

The Village hereby approves the Agreement, substantially in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof collectively as Exhibit A.

Section Three – Authorization and Direction

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to execute, and the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to attest the Agreement, substantially in the form of such agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such changes therein as shall be approved by the Village Attorney and the officials of the Village executing the same, their execution thereof to constitute exclusive evidence of their approval to any and all changes or revisions therein from and after the execution and delivery of such Agreement.

Section Four - Other Actions Authorized

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

Section Five - Authorization of Expenditures

The Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the expenditure of all costs related to the execution of the Agreement, additionally, the Village is authorized and directed to allocate and spend all necessary funds to fulfill the requirements of the agreement and of this resolution.

Section Six – Waiver of Bidding Requirements

To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable to the transactions contemplated hereunder, the same is hereby waived.

Section Seven - Acts of Village Officials

That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

Section Eight – Effective Date

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Nine - Publication

This resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Ten – Conflict Clause

All resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Eleven – Saving Clause

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of any other provisions of this resolution, which are hereby declared to be separable.

Section Twelve – Recording

This resolution shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: I move to Approve Resolution 2020 DCL-EM-VOB-COVID-19-R-1867, A Resolution Approving and Authorizing A Declaration of Emergency COVID-19.

Background/History:

Village President Gopal Lalimalani issued a disaster proclamation for the Village of Oak Brook in response to the COVID-19 situation. By issuing a disaster proclamation, the Village officially activated its Emergency Operations Plan and will continue to work with local, state, and federal partners to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak. This resolution of a state of emergency in Oak Brook, allows the Village to become eligible for additional funding for our operational response. It will expire 60 days from the date of passage.

Recommendation:

That the Village Board approves the resolution.

RESOLUTION R-1867

**A RESOLUTION
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING
A DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
COVID-19**

WHEREAS, the United States Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), and the World Health Organization (WHO) have each determined that SARS-CoV-2 virus causes the COVID-19 respiratory disease;

WHEREAS, the SARS-CoV-2 virus is a new strain of coronavirus that had not been previously identified in humans and is easily spread from person to person and the COVID-19 disease can result in serious illness or death;

WHEREAS, dozens of confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been identified in the State of Illinois; to date, all of the cases in Illinois are in the greater Chicagoland area;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the Secretary of HHS declared a public health emergency for the entire United States of America concerning COVID-19, on March 9, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued a disaster proclamation concerning the spread of COVID-19 in Illinois, on March 11, 2020, WHO declared that the spread of COVID-19 is a global pandemic, on March 13, 2020 President Trump declared a national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic and on March 15, 2020 DuPage County Board Chairman Cronin issued a disaster proclamation concerning the spread of COVID-19 in DuPage County and on March 20, 2020 Governor Pritzker issued an order for all residents of Illinois to “shelter in place”;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Department of Public Health has now confirmed localized community person-to-person transmission of COVID-19 in Illinois, significantly increasing the risk of exposure and infection to Illinois’ general public and creating an extreme public health risk in the Village and throughout the State;

WHEREAS, as has been experienced in other locales in the United States and around the world, the SARS-CoV-2 virus has the potential to infect large numbers of people in a short amount of time, placing extreme burdens on the health care system and the economy; and

WHEREAS, that the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Oak Brook understand that this is a fluid situation ever changing and in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the Village, and to protect the residents of the Village from disease and death, it is necessary to issue this Declaration to implement emergency regulations and orders, all as set forth in this Declaration.

Section One - Statement of Authority

This Declaration is issued pursuant to the authority granted under the Village of Oak Brook Code of Ordinances, as amended; Section 11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6; and Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11.

Section Two – Declaration

The Corporate Authorities of the Village of Oak Brook hereby declare that a state of emergency and a state of disaster exists in the Village of Oak Brook for the reasons set forth in this Declaration.

Section Three - Emergency Regulations and Orders

The Village hereby directs and orders as follows:

- a) *Emergency Purchasing.* The Village may enter into contracts for the emergency purchase of goods and services that may be necessary for the preparation for, response to, and recovery from, the COVID-19 pandemic. The Village President and the Village Manager are hereby authorized to execute such contracts in accordance with applicable law.
- b) *Emergency Staffing.* This Declaration constitutes a declaration of civil emergency under the Village's collective bargaining agreements. Accordingly, the Village President is authorized and directed to implement such emergency staffing protocols and procedures as may be necessary for the preservation of public health and safety, and for the preservation of the health of Village employees. Specifically, and without limitation of the foregoing, the Village President is authorized to implement alternative staffing protocols, procedures, and shifts for the Village Fire, Police, and Public Works Departments.
- c) *Cooperation with Other Government Agencies.* All Village officials and employees are directed to take all practicable steps to coordinate the Village's resources and emergency operations with the State of Illinois, the County of DuPage, and other local governments in and around the Village, to best utilize resources of all agencies in the area for the preparation for, response to, and recovery from, the COVID-19 pandemic.
- d) Consistent with Governor Pritzker's Executive Order 2020-10, which authorizes each municipality to determine its Essential Government functions, the Village excludes all Emergency Responders from coverage under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, Public Law 116-127, to the maximum extent permitted by federal law.

Section Four - Other Actions Authorized

The Village President is hereby authorized to issue additional emergency regulations and orders in furtherance of this Declaration. Notice of any additional regulations and orders will be provided to the Village Clerk, posted on the Village website, and otherwise provided to the general public as quickly as practicable.

Section Five - Effective Date and Period of Emergency

This declaration shall take effect immediately and shall expire 60 days from the effective date set forth herein.

Section Seven – Publication

This declaration shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Ten – Recording

This declaration shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook.

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-FIHM-TX-G-1162

**AN ORDINANCE
PERTAINING TO
TITLE 5 CHAPTER 5 OF
THE VILLAGE OF OAK BROOK
CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Village of Oak Brook (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") is an Illinois Municipal Corporation organized pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of ordinances which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Oak Brook, as amended;

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs that protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents including the adoption and imposition of certain taxes;

WHEREAS, the Village pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-3-4 has previously adopted a Hotel and Motel Tax which has been implemented for the purpose of promoting tourism and conventions or otherwise to attract nonresident overnight visitors to the Village of Oak Brook;

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2020, the Secretary of HHS declared a public health emergency for the entire United States of America concerning COVID-19, on March 9, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued a disaster proclamation concerning the spread of COVID-19 in Illinois, on March 11, 2020, WHO declared that the spread of COVID-19 is a global pandemic, on March 13, 2020 President Trump declared a national emergency concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, on March 15, 2020 DuPage County Board Chairman Cronin issued a disaster proclamation concerning the spread of COVID-19 in DuPage County and on March 20, 2020 Governor Pritzker issued an order for all residents of Illinois to "shelter in place";

WHEREAS, the Village has adopted an Emergency Declaration pertaining to COVID-19 and is interested to the extent possible provide relief to businesses located within the corporate limits of the Village of Oak Brook;

WHEREAS, businesses throughout the State of Illinois have been negatively impacted by the spread of COVID-19 and the related shelter in place order issued by Governor Pritzker;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities are of the opinion that without immediate financial assistance to the hotels and motels within the Village said establishments will suffer severe financial hardship and may be forced to permanently cease operations thus eliminating any possibility to attract nonresident overnight visitors;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Oak Brook desire to rebate certain funds collected as a result of the Hotel and Motel Tax to those respective hotels and motels for a designated period of time to assist those businesses in remaining open during this extraordinary time; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Oak Brook are of the opinion that that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents to rebate the Hotel and Motel Tax for the time period referenced herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Rebate of Hotel and Motel Tax

- a) The Corporate Authorities of the Village of Oak Brook hereby find that the expenditure defined herein as a “rebate” is necessary to assist in maintaining and promoting the attraction of tourism and the accommodation of nonresident overnight visitors to the Village of Oak Brook;
- b) The Village Oak Brook hereby authorizes a rebate to each Hotel and Motel in the amount of the Hotel and Motel tax paid by the respective hotels and motels and collected by the Village of Oak Brook for the time period referenced herein, payment of the rebate shall be made to each of the hotels and motels within 5 business days of the date said amount of the Hotel and Motel Tax is collected by the Village during the authorized time period set forth herein; and
- c) The authorized time period for the rebate shall be made to each of the hotels and/or motels for hotel/motel stays during the period from January 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020.
- d) The terms and conditions of this ordinance have been enacted as a result of the extraordinary circumstances resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, the provisions of this ordinance shall automatically terminate upon the close of business on the last day of the authorized time period defined herein.

Section Three – Effective Date

That this ordinance become effective as of January 1, 2020 to the extent that any funds have been collected from the hotels and motels referenced herein.

Section Four - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances, parts of ordinances or board actions in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Five - Passage Clause

That this ordinance shall take full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Six - Constitutionality Clause

Any part or parts of this ordinance declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or the Oak Brook Municipal Code.

Section Seven - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Eight - Recording

This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oak Brook.
