Services for patrons with impaired vision

Voices of Vision is a free service offered to people who are blind or physically disabled, sponsored by the Library of Congress and the Illinois State Library. You qualify for this service if you cannot read conventional print because of a visual impairment or cannot hold a book due to a physical disability.

Voices of Vision provides books and magazines in audio and Braille format for individuals unable to read regular print.

To initiate service, an application form must be filled out at the Library.
