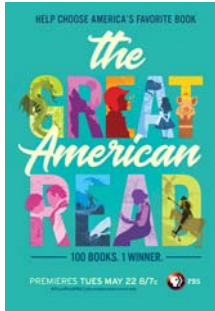


Summer Reading - Reading Takes You Everywhere
