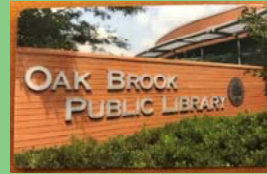

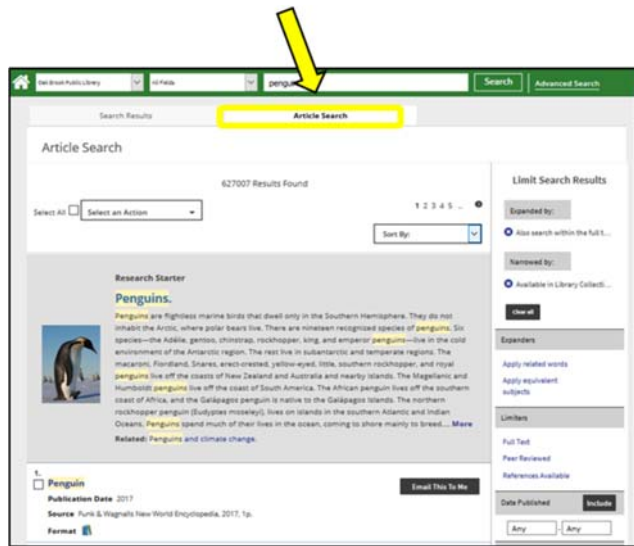
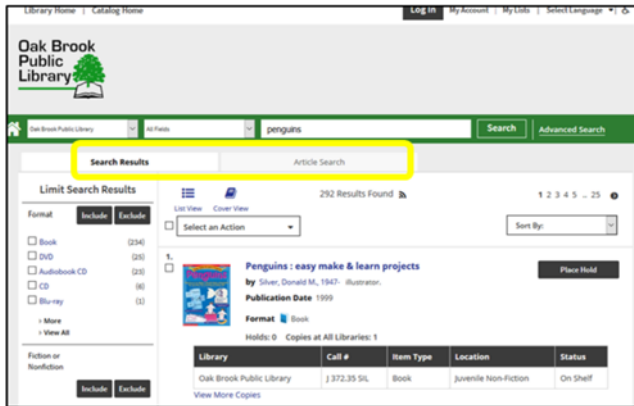
# Access to Articles and More

This club is open to players who have an understanding of the game. This is not a team so players are welcome to join us to improve their game & play! **Registration Required.**



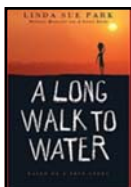
### Books & Bites Book Discussion
